## Re-opening safely



We're delighted to be gradually re-opening our facilities and offering group activities in line with current Scottish Government guidance and Scouts Scotland readiness levels.

We can't wait to welcome you back, and want to share some information with you about how we're going to keep you safe and make sure you enjoy your visit. The health and safety of our staff, volunteers and visitors is the most important thing to us. We've put some new procedures in place from phase 3 that we will continue to review, and need your help with to make sure we're all safe.

### Bookings

- Please contact the centre by email to make an individual or group booking
- Group sizes will be limited and based on current guidance
- On the day of your booking, if any individuals are displaying covid-19 symptoms, you must contact us to cancel their place and any other accompanying household members, and we will refund this payment
- If you are a Scout group you must have had your return to face-to-face Scouting approved locally at the appropriate level before you can visit

### What you'll need to bring

- Each individual should bring their own hand sanitiser for use.
- Please bring a face mask to wear in case you need to go inside any building and /or for situations where 2 metre distancing is not possible.
- We can't provide any food, drinks or utensils, but you're very welcome to bring your own.

\*Please note there will be sanitising stations around the site and additional disposable face masks if required

### What will happen when you visit us

- We'll give you an arrival slot time and meeting location before you visit us. Please make sure you stick to these.
- You must keep physical distancing at all times in line with guidance.
- You must register on arrival and departure so we can comply with test and tracing.
- Each group will be given separate toilet facilities to keep groups completely separate during your visit.
- You'll be asked to help us to sanitise equipment and surfaces after activities, use of toilet facilities and refreshment breaks.
- We have signs up around the site to support distancing. Please make sure you follow these.

### What else we're doing to keep you safe

- We will have extra cleaning in place to support hygiene management with busy areas being regularly cleaned throughout the day.
- Equipment will be washed/disinfected and dried between uses. Personal protective equipment will be quarantined for 72 hours before cleaning and being back in use.
- Activity touch points will be cleaned by instructors after each group's use.
